



Minutes of an
Extraordinary Parochial Church Meeting
held in the church at 11:30am on Sunday
30th November 2025

Meeting chaired by the vicar, Reverend David Willis

1. Apologies for Absence

Apologies were received from Catrina Lambert.

2. Election of Clerk to the Meeting

The meeting elected Sally Carr to take minutes.

3. Report on the proceedings of the PCC and the activities of the Parish Generally (for the year ending 31st December 2024).

The report which had been presented in draft form at the APCM in May 2025 was received without questions or comments. Revd. Dave thanked all in the parish for their contributions to the work of the church.

4. Financial Report and Accounts for the year ending 31st December 2024.

The accounts had not been presented at the APCM in May 2025 but were received without question or comment at this meeting. Revd. Dave offered his thanks to Colin Russell and Paul Dyer both of whom had served as Treasurer during 2024. Thanks were also offered to Graham Lane the Independent Examiner.

Revd. Dave thanked the meeting for the very positive response to the stewardship push during Lent 2025. It had been identified in late 2024 that the financial situation was such that we would not be able to pay 100% of our Parish Share in 2025. The PCC had committed to make monthly payments equivalent to 50%, to have a stewardship push during Lent, and to make a final lump sum payment to the Diocesan Board of Finance at the end of 2025 such that we would end the year in the same financial state. The response so far suggested that there would be a reasonable lump sum to give.

Revd. Dave reminded the meeting that Paul Dyer had resigned his position as Treasurer and that we were looking for people interested in taking this on. He suggested that aspects of the role could be shared with others (such as banking, the hall finances, gift aid or stewardship) to lessen the load on the Treasurer.
